
"The girl's name was Mary."

- \* white or gold lace doily

- **#** glitter


The scalloped edge of the coffee filter will be the hem of the angel's gown. Squirt glue on the angel's hem. Dip in glitter.




This is the angel's body.

2 Cut a circle from brown or pink paper.
Glue it to the top of the cone.

This is the angel's face.





5 Glue a quarter of a coffee filter to the angel's back. These are the angel's wings.
